

Project Name: NYC Japanese Connection Project

Required Materials: Genki textbook (Chapter 1 vocabulary list), internet-connected device (computer or smartphone), notebook or digital document (e.g., Google Docs), pen or typing tool.

Language Skills Practiced: Understanding and using the “Noun1 の Noun2” grammatical structure, vocabulary recall from Genki Chapter 1, basic sentence formation, and reading online Japanese-related content.

Time Required: Approximately 1 hour.

Detailed Steps:

1. Review the vocabulary from Genki Chapter 1 (e.g., がくせい、せんせい、にほんご、ほん、てがみ、ともだち、アメリカ、だいがく). Focus on nouns that can be combined using “の”.
2. Using online resources, search for Japanese-related places or organizations in New York City (e.g., Kinokuniya Bookstore, Japan Society, Ippudo Ramen, Japanese Cultural Center). Visit their websites or online pages (e.g., Google Maps, Yelp, official sites) to gather information.
3. For each place or organization found, identify two relevant nouns from Genki Chapter 1 vocabulary (e.g., for a Japanese bookstore: ほん、にほん; for a language school: がくせい、にほんご).
4. Create at least 10 original sentences using the “Noun1 の Noun2” structure, based on the researched places. Examples:
 - にほんごのがくせいです。
 - ほんのてんいんです。
 - アメリカのともだちです。

Ensure all nouns used are from Genki Chapter 1 vocabulary.

5. Compile the sentences into a digital document or notebook. Include screenshots or links to the online sources used for reference.
6. Format the deliverable as a PDF or shared document with the sentences listed clearly, along with the source information.

Deliverable: A submitted document (PDF or shared link) containing:

- A list of at least 10 sentences using “Noun1 の Noun2” based on NYC Japanese-related places.
- Screenshots or URLs of the online sources used for research.
- Your name and date on the document.
