

**Project Name:** Particle Practice: NYC Japanese Contexts

**Required Materials:** - “Genki” textbook (Chapters 1-3 vocabulary list) - Internet access - Writing tools (e.g., notebook, digital device) - List of Japanese-related locations in New York or online Japanese websites (provided below)

**Language Skills to Practice:** - Using particles (e.g., に, で, を, へ) in sentences - Constructing simple sentences with Ch.1-3 vocabulary - Applying vocabulary in real-world contexts

**Time Needed:** Approximately 1 hour

**Detailed Steps:** 1. Review particles and vocabulary from “Genki” Ch.1-3. Focus on particles like で, に, を, へ and nouns/verbs such as 本, 雑誌, 学校, 行きます, 読みます, 食べます. 2. Use the following list of Japanese-related places in New York or online websites. Choose 5 items from this list: - Kinokuniya Bookstore (New York) - Japan Society (New York) - Online: Japan National Tourism Organization (JNTO) website (simple English/Japanese pages) - Online: NHK World-Japan (use basic news or culture sections) - Local Japanese restaurant (e.g., research online menus or reviews) - Online: Tofugu blog (for beginner Japanese content) 3. For each chosen location or website, write 2 sentences in Japanese using particles from Ch.1-3. Ensure all vocabulary is from “Genki” Ch.1-3. Example sentences: - キノクニヤで本を読みます。 - がっこうに友だちと行きます。 4. Compile the 10 sentences into a deliverable: a text file, PDF, or shared document with each sentence labeled by location/website. 5. Submit the deliverable to your instructor or peer for review.
