Project Name: NYC Japanese Time Scavenger Hunt

**Required Materials:** Smartphone or computer with internet access, notebook/pen, Genki textbook (Ch.1–Ch.3 vocabulary list), map or list of NYC Japanese locations (provided below).

**Language Skills Practiced:** Asking and telling time, using time-related expressions, basic sentence formation with  $\sharp \tau$ -form verbs.

**Time Required:** Approximately 60 minutes.

# **Step 1: Preparation (10 minutes)**

Review Genki Ch.1-Ch.3 vocabulary for time, daily activities, and basic verbs.

Write down these key words/phrases:

- 何時、~時、~時半、~分、午前、午後
- Verbs: 起きます、寝ます、勉強します、食べます、行きます、来ます、働きます
- Other: 今、毎日、ときどき、学校、仕事、家、大学、レストラン

#### **Step 2: Location List (Use these NYC-based Japanese spots for reference)**

Physical locations in NYC:

- 1. Kinokuniya Bookstore (Midtown)
- 2. Sunrise Mart (East Village or Midtown)
- 3. Japan Society (Midtown East)
- 4. Muji Store (SoHo or Midtown)

## **Step 3: Activity Instructions (30 minutes)**

Choose one physical location or website from the list.

Research and find the following information using the site or your knowledge of the spot:

- 1. Open/close time (何時に開きますか。何時に閉まりますか。)
- 2. Event time (if any) (何時にイベントがありますか。)
- 3. Your own hypothetical schedule for visiting:
- Example: 私は午前十一時半に Sunrise Mart に行きます。
- Write 3 sentences about your plan using time + activity.

#### **Step 4: Deliverable Creation (15 minutes)**

Create a simple poster or digital slide (can be handwritten or typed) titled 「私のニューヨークの日本タイムスケジュール」.

## Include:

- 1. The name and a picture of the chosen location.
- 2.3 found time facts (e.g., 「Sunrise Mart は午前九時に開きます。」).
- 3. 3 original sentences about your planned visit using time + activity from Step 3.
- 4. One question you could ask an employee there (e.g.,「何時にクッキングクラスがありますか。」).

# **Step 5: Submission**

Submit your poster/slide to your teacher or class platform. Optionally, share with a partner and ask/answer each other's questions verbally.
