Project Name: "と in NYC: Japanese Connection Hunt"

Textbook Reference: Genki I, Chapters 1-4 only

Target Language Skill: Using the particle "∠" to connect nouns (e.g., "A ∠ B")

Time Required: Approximately 60 minutes

Materials Needed: Internet access, notebook/word processor, camera or screenshot tool (optional).

STEP 1: Preparation (10 minutes)

- 1. Review Genki Ch.1-4 vocabulary lists.
- 2. Write down 10-15 nouns from the textbook that relate to items, places, or activities (e.g., ほん, コーヒー, がっこう, てがみ, レストラン).

STEP 2: Research Online (25 minutes)

- 1. Choose one real Japanese-related location in NYC (or a Japanese website if local). Examples:
- Kinokuniya Bookstore (NYC)
- Sunrise Mart (Japanese grocery)
- Japan Society (NYC)
- Online: Official website of a Japanese prefecture (e.g., Tokyo Tourism website)
- 2. Explore the location/website. Find three specific things offered or shown there.
- 3. For each thing, write one sentence using " $\ensuremath{\mbox{\ensuremath{\mbox{\sc v}}}}$ " to connect it with another item from your vocabulary list.

Example:

- きのくにやでまんが**と**ざっしをかいます。
- サンライズマートでコーヒー**と**おちゃをみます。

Use only vocabulary from Genki Ch.1-4.

STEP 3: Create Deliverable (20 minutes)

- 1. Make a simple digital or handwritten post:
- Title: ニューヨークの [Location Name]
- Add 3 sentences using "\u2" from Step 2.
- Include one photo/screenshot of the location (optional).
- 2. Format as a social-media-style post (e.g., mock Instagram post, short blog entry).

STEP 4: Submit (5 minutes)

Submit your post (digital file or photo of handwritten page) to your instructor.

Deliverable: A social-media-style post in Japanese containing 3 sentences using "\(\gamma \)" with Ch.1-4 vocabulary, based on a real Japanese-related location/website.
